1. Musical Bumps Ltd believes that children must be protected from harm at all times.
2. We believe every child should be valued, safe and happy. We want to make sure that children we have contact with know this.
3. We want children who use or have contact with Musical Bumps to enjoy what we have to offer in safety.
4. We want parents and carers who use or attend Musical Bumps to be supported to care for their children in a way that promotes their child's health and well-being and keeps them safe.
5. We will achieve this by having an effective child protection procedure and following National and Local guidance.
6. If we discover or suspect a child is suffering harm we will notify social services or the police in order that they can be protected if necessary.
7. This child protection policy and our child protection procedure apply to all staff, volunteers and users of Musical Bumps and anyone carrying out any work for us.
8. We will review our child protection policy and procedures at least every 2 years to make sure they are still relevant and effective.
9. Photography and filming. No video or still photography may be taken during Musical Bumps classes without the express permission (which may be verbal) of parents and carers attending. If Musical Bumps staff or franchisees wish to take photographs or make videos then written permission from parents must first be sought
